



## REGULATIONS FOR USING THE PADDLING POOL AND WATER ATTRACTIONS

1. The paddling pool, and water attractions located in it, form an integral part of the Aqua Park Zakopane pool hall, therefore the general pool regulations and additional detailed regulations apply.
2. The guardian of a child using water attractions is required to read these regulations, the building's regulations, information boards, markings and instructions in force at the facility before using the water attractions and to explain the safety rules to the child.
3. The paddling pool attractions are only for children remaining under the constant care of their parents or adult guardians. Parents and guardians are responsible for the safety of children.
4. Guardians are obliged to supervise children at all times when using the paddling pool and its water attractions, and stay in a place close to the paddling pool in visual contact with the child, so that the distance to the child would allow them for a quick response to any event.
5. The paddling pool and attractions in it are place of fun and relaxation.
6. Attractions in the paddling pool are intended for children under the age of 10, remaining under the constant care of adults.
7. Groups can stay in the paddling pool under the care of a guardian.
8. Water toys that are equipped with a hand pump and are intended only for use by children, it is also forbidden to jerk and hang on the handle of the pump.
9. There can be only one person at a time standing on the starting platform for the water slide.
10. It is forbidden to run onto the slide, the user should climb with caution.
11. When climbing the slide's starting platform, be particularly cautious and remember to keep your sliding position - with your feet facing the water surface. It is advisable for the guardian to hold the child's hand during sliding.
12. A child that gives up sliding down must be allowed to leave the slide at all times.
13. It is forbidden to cause situations that threaten one's own safety, or the safety of others using the paddling pool and the swimming pool hall or which may cause an unfortunate accident, and in particular:
  - stepping on components not intended for this purpose,
  - forcing a child to slide,
  - performing a slide in pairs or in a group,
  - sliding down with items that could cause injury,
  - entering the slide from the end element side and climbing the slide towards the starting point,
  - diving and going under the water attractions of the paddling pool
  - staying within the slide landing area,
  - using the paddling pool tray when the access thereto is closed by a chain, rope or other visible means
14. Supervision over compliance with these regulations is performed by: Childminders, Lifeguards, Swimming Pool Employees. All persons using the paddling pool are obliged to follow their instructions.
15. After leaving the paddling pool, any defects noticed regarding slides and other attractions should be immediately reported to the lifeguard.
16. In the event of an accident caused by non-compliance with the paddling pool and slides regulations, the user will bear the exclusive responsibility.
17. All persons violating public order or the provisions of these regulations will be removed from the paddling pool area, and from the swimming pool area.
